## STATUS OF CONSTRUCTION, DEMOLITIONS, AND NEW BUILDINGS:



1. **Campus Center** is nearing completion with turn-over of the building to the campus anticipated by the end of March. New furniture will be delivered in April and May (in time for the May 7<sup>th</sup> Employee Awards event we hope). The formal move into the Campus Center will occur the week of May 23 to include:
  - **Cafeteria & Restaurant Management program**
  - **Bookstore**
  - **Campus Police**
  - **Student Activities / Student Government**
  - **CalWorks**
  - **SAP (Student Assistance Program)**
  - **Institutional Development & Foundation**
  - **Scholarships**
  - **Weekend College**
  - **Dean, Occupational Education & Extended Day**
  - **Grants Management**
  - **Research**
2. The new **Art Center** complex is also nearing completion with an anticipated move-in date set for the week of May 23.
3. The new **Child Care Center** continues to make progress towards an anticipated move occurring prior to the beginning of the fall semester.
4. The new **Student Health Services Center** has been delayed and will not be constructed by fall 2006 as planned. We are hopeful that the new modular structure will be ready by the beginning of spring semester, 2007.
5. Now that the demolitions are nearing completion, we will have an empty space the size of the Rose Bowl (over 18 acres) and shortly after the finals and commencement, construction begins on the parkway, which should take place throughout 2006-2007.
