

New Board of Governors Fee Waiver (BOGFW) Changes

New regulations from the California Community College Chancellors Office will affect the student BOG Fee Waiver program and Priority Enrollment.

- Loss of BOG Fee Waiver/Priority Enrollment will occur if a student has two consecutive semesters (excludes Summer session) of not meeting Academic (2.0 GPA or above) or Progress standards (More than 50% Completion Rate) and are placed on Academic Dismissal.
- Students will have the right to appeal the loss of their BOG Fee Waiver and Priority Enrollment.
- Students will have their BOGFW/Priority Enrollment reinstated if one of the following applies:
 - * Meeting Academic Progress Standards
 - * Successful Appeal
 - * Sitting out two consecutive primary terms
