- Submit a SBVC Admissions application online, Valley-Bound Commitment application 500 word essay and high school transcripts
- Attend one of the 14 designated high schools and graduate with a high school diploma
- ☑ Serve 30 hours of community service over 2 semesters
- ☑ Be recognized as "financial aid eligible" by the SBVC Financial Aid office (start by applying for financial aid at www.fafsa.ed.gov and fulfill all requirements)
- ☐ Take the assessment test and enroll in basic skills courses as determined by the assessment test.
- ☑ Enroll in Student Development courses to ensure seamless transition into college
- ☑ Student must maintain a college GPA of at least 2.0
