

# Pharmacy Technology Program

## About the Program

The Pharmacy Technology Program prepares students to work in pharmacies to fill prescriptions, stock supplies, and sell to the public under the supervision of a pharmacist. Students are admitted in the Fall and Spring semesters. Enroll in first semester classes listed below. The program may be taken full-time or part-time. If taken full-time, the certificate may be completed in 2 semesters. Students may also elect to earn an Associate Degree. Students must have a basic knowledge of arithmetic, reading and writing in order to learn and work in this vocational field. Courses in this program are accepted by the California Board of Pharmacy. To become registered the California Board of Pharmacy requires an application (with fee), fingerprinting, and High School completion. A history of convictions related to the practice of this vocation may result in denial of the state license.
