 - ☐ New Students: 1st Semester Education Plan or 2 Year Education Plan
 - ☐ Current Students: 2 Year Education Plan
- ☐ Certificate of Eligibility (You will receive this from the VA)
- ☐ Request For Change of Program or Place of Training: Form 22-1995 Submitted on www.vabenefits.vba.va.gov Print form after submitting online (*If Applicable*)
- ☐ Official Transcripts from other colleges (*If Applicable*)

If you have switched from chapter 30 or chapter 1606, Montgomery GI Bill; or Chapter 1607, Reservist Educational Assistance Program (REAP), to chapter 33 the Post 9/11 GI Bill, you do not have to verify your attendance each month. WAVE will still reflect your previous benefit, but the only action you can take will be to check pending documents. If you are eligible only for the Post 9/11 GI Bill, you will not have access to WAVE.
