- Public Comment/Guest: SBCCD Chancellor Bruce Baron
 Bruce Baron gave us an update on recent college business. He said that salaries are in negotiations and that they are using information from the Hay Group Study for the negotiations. There is a backlog in hiring positions. There are 40 positions that need to be filled. He said that his goal is to gear up the recruitment process. He wants to have the policies and procedures updated from a legal point of view. We will keep the interim president through the accreditation process, and then we will recruit for a new president after that. For the Brain Trust Report they will send out a report on what will be implemented. We need an enrollment management plan as we want to increase enrollment by 4%. We will need to use our resources to do that, and then the state will come in. For KVCRC we will take money out of the reserves to support them for another year. We want to use our redevelopment funds for capital improvements. We want to bring back community services, so we will be starting with a pilot program in Yucaipa and Redlands. The facilities will be free and we want it to be self- supporting. It will be a fee based program. This will go to board in April .Mary Valdemar asked about our history of positions being abolished and not being refilled. Bruce Baron stated that he supports re-establishing these positions. He said that they will put the positions back on the books even though we don't have the money for them yet. Then we will start prioritizing to re-establish the positions. Barbara Nichols said that she is concerned about the laborious processes we have to get things done, and things getting bogged down. We will create a small user group to work out the problems in our processes.
