Distance Education

Courses in which the instructor and student are separated by distance and interact through the assistance of communication technology. (AP 4105, Title 5)

Online

Courses facilitated through a Learning Management System (Canvas). Instructor-student and student-student interactions and communication occurs through a learning management system, such as Canvas. Courses may be scheduled asynchronously (with no scheduled meeting times), synchronously (with scheduled meeting times), or in a hybrid format. Courses may or may not have proctored exams and assignments.

Synchronous

Conducted fully online. You are required to attend scheduled meetings on Zoom or other video conference platform as part of the course requirements.

Asynchronous

Conducted fully online. You are not required to come to campus or attend scheduled meetings as part of the course requirements.

Hybrid

Courses have both on-campus and online components. On-campus in-person components are scheduled in advance and published in the course schedule. Online components may be scheduled in a synchronous or asynchronous format. The online portion of the course uses a Learning Management System (Canvas).

Hybrid Synchronous

Course includes required scheduled meeting sessions in-person and required scheduled meeting sessions online. You are required to attend scheduled meetings on campus and online through Zoom or other video conference platform as part of the course requirements.

Hybrid Asynchronous

Course is conducted online and in-person. You are required to come to campus meetings and required to complete asynchronous (not scheduled) online material as part of the course.

Web Enhanced

An in-person, on-campus course requiring you to access online content, assessments, and/or submissions as determined by the instructor.
