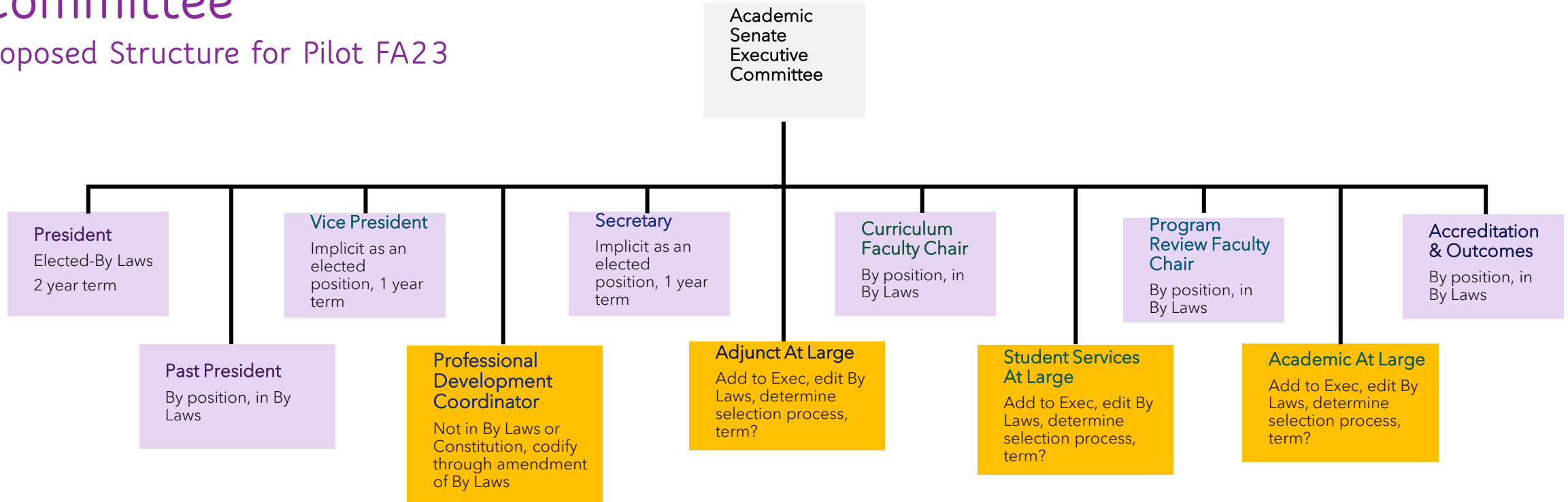

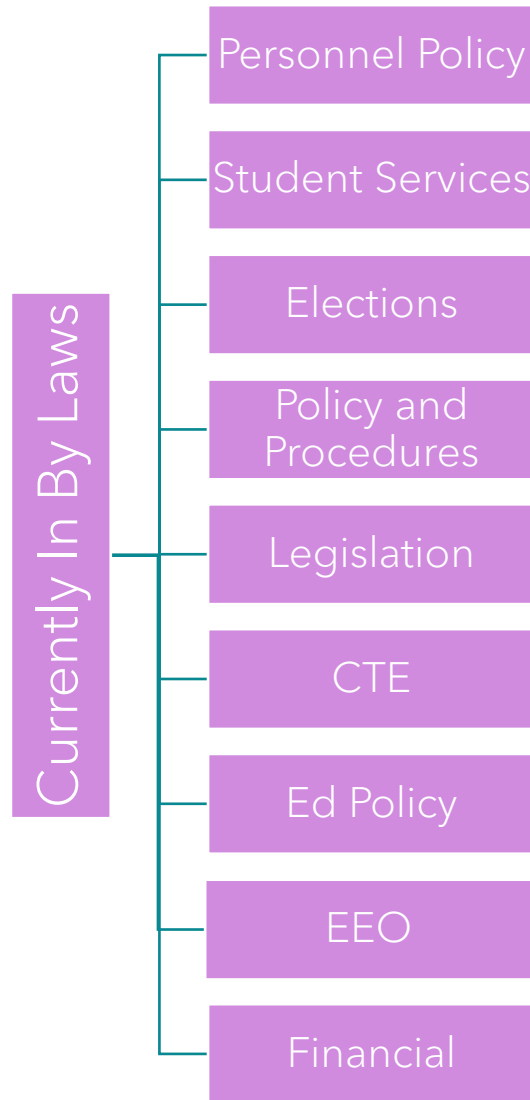

Proposed Structure for Pilot FA23

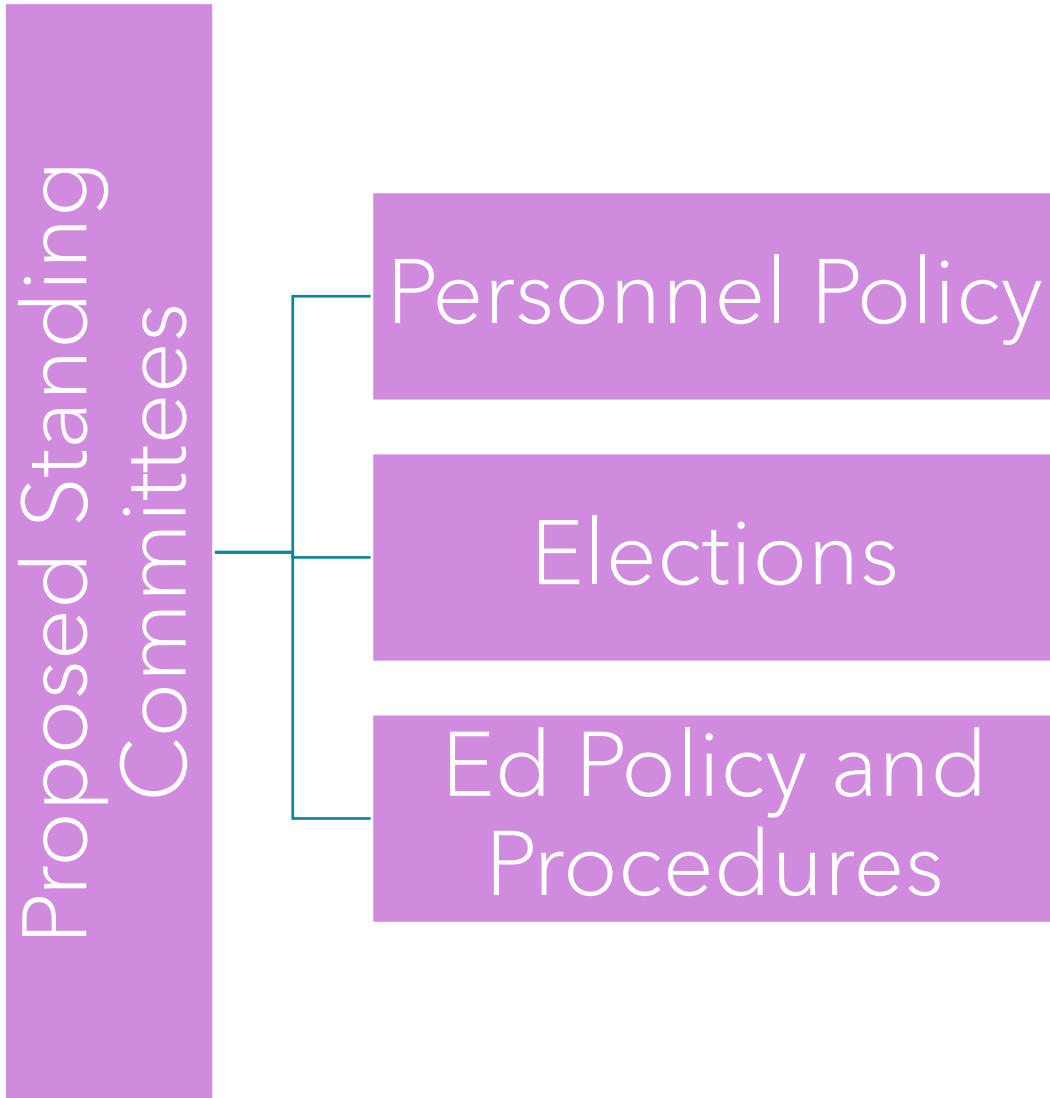


Standing Committees of the Academic Senate

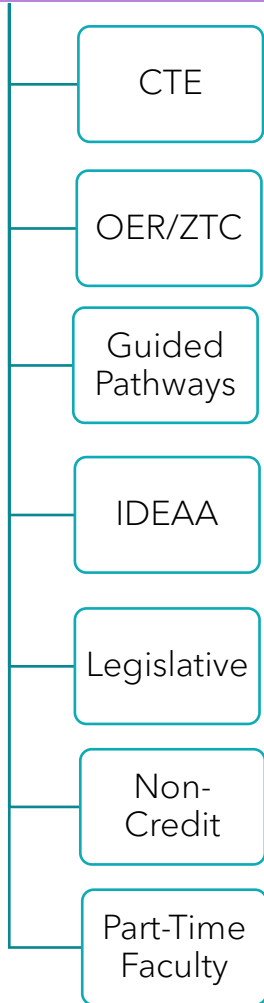

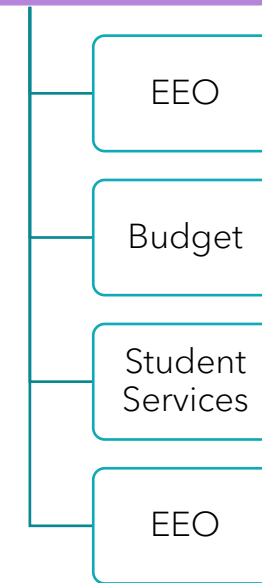

ASCCC Liaison Positions

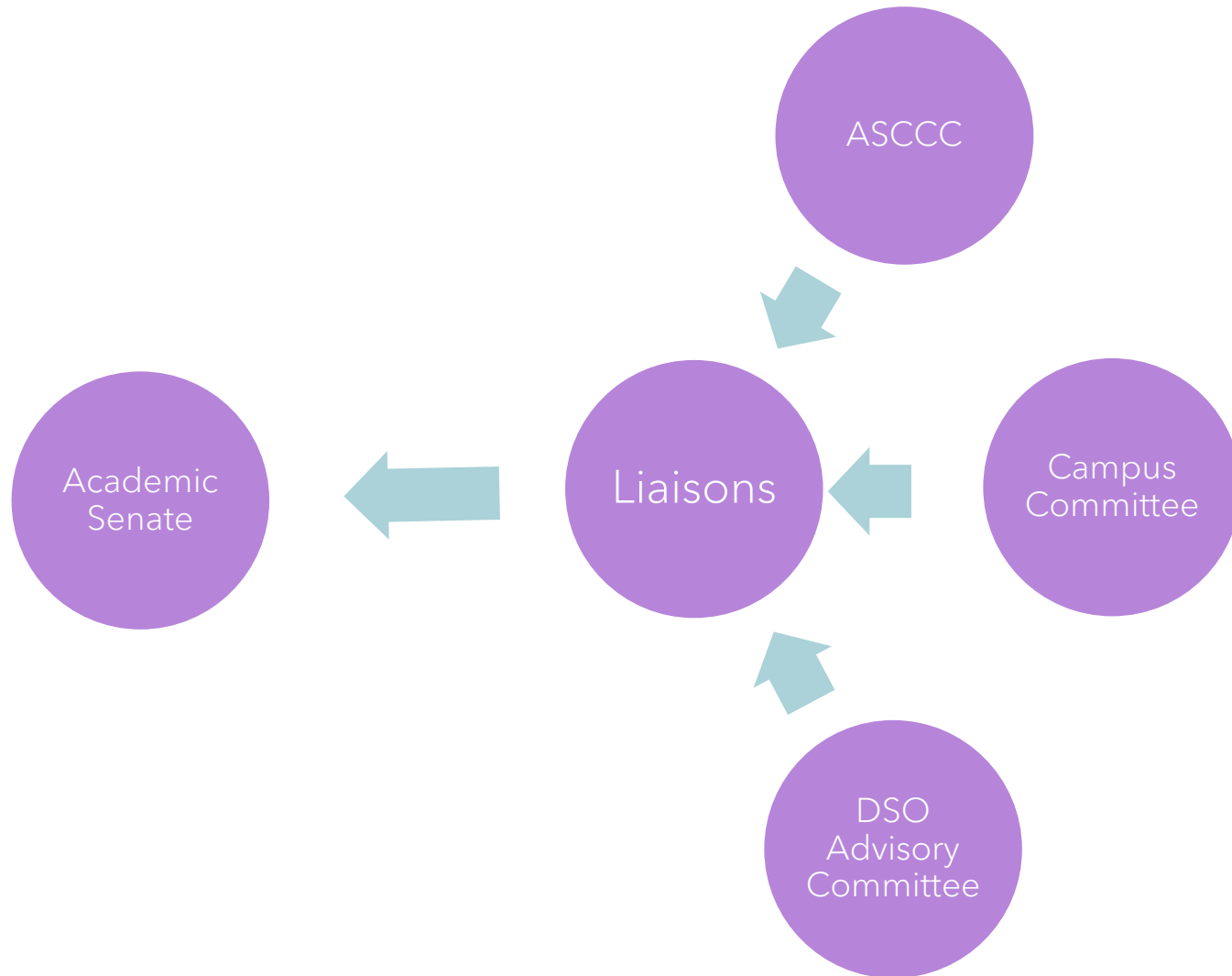


SBVC Liaison Positions

Further Conversation

- Executive Committee
 - Term Length for Elected Positions
 - Election cycle for Executive Committee
 - Chair Standing Committees of the Senate
 - Serve on DSO Advisory Committee
 - Executive Committee membership counts as Committee Service
- At Large Positions
 - Elected from Senate body or body at large
- Liaisons
 - Need to be Senators or general faculty body
 - Frequency of reporting/updating to Senate
 - Establish clear communication patterns and expectations
