# **CLASSIFIED SENATE MEETING MINUTES**

JUNE 25, 2020

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order 12:34 p.m.

Attendees: See sign-in sheet

<u>Approval of Agenda</u>: Phylicia Sanchez proposed to add to the agenda to add John Feist to New Business to update the financial accounts; John Feist motioned to approve the agenda with addendum; Michael Gonzales 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. The agenda was approved by general consensus.

<u>Approval of Minutes</u>: The minutes from June 11, 2020, were not available and tabled to the next meeting. John Feist motioned to tale the minutes to the next meeting; Ernest Guillen 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion.

**Public Comment/Guest:** There was no guest speaker for this meeting. Ernest Guillen took a moment to let everyone know that this is the last time he will be facilitating the Classified Senate meeting in the absence of Judy Rodriguez, President, who took a leave of absence from SBVC.

## Reports:

- A. <u>President:</u> Ernie Guillen met with Diana Rodriguez and they discussed a couple of items: Classified Senate staff engaging in shared governance and manager approval—many employees are asked to use their lunch time or make-up time to attend committee meetings. One of the president's priorities is for staff to participate in the shared governance process. She proposed to get a list of managers who are practicing this process so that she can emphasis to the managers to approve their classified employees to participate in committees. She said that she cannot address something that she does not know. There was discussion on this topic, a proposal to have the Classified Senate to be the eyes and ears to report to CSEA site reps when this issue is occurring. There is a Standard Operation Procedure (SOP), further discussion on the district negotiating with the Classified Senate when they are to negotiate with CSEA.
- B. <u>Treasurer</u>: Phylicia Sanchez reviewed the current accounts with Valley Hills Credit Union and the SBVC Foundation Office. We are ending the current fiscal and will begin the new fiscal year on July 1, 2020.

- C. <u>CSEA</u>: Ernie Guillen reviewed the budget report from the Governor/State level, noting that all districts, schools and colleges are to receive the same funding as last year. He noted that the campus is closed on Thursday, July 2<sup>nd</sup>, in observance of the July 4<sup>th</sup> holiday, which falls on a Saturday.
- D. <u>Other:</u>
  - a. <u>Mary Valdemar</u> commented on the budget update from the State noting that this is a good example when people work together on an end goal. She said there is an assembly bill coming on ethnic studies (K-12) to be added to graduation requirements. She will be attending a PAC meeting this weekend.

## New Business:

A. <u>New President/Signature Change for Banking:</u> Reminder that we need minutes of the elections with names to present to the Valley Hills Credit Union to change over to John Feist, Classified Senate President, effective 7/1/2020. Mary Valedmar motioned to verify John Feist to replace Judy Rodriguez on banking info eff. 7/1/2020; Dena Peters 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. Approved by general consensus.

#### **Discussion:**

- A. <u>Open Forum</u>: Ernie Guillen said we will move forward to set up an open forum to discuss equity, inclusion, diversity, etc. We want to follow-up on issues, find the system problem, look at hiring panels and diversity, and review the committee list.
- B. <u>Committee List</u>: The Classified Senate will send out the most recent committee list to all classified staff. Discussion ensued on having classified staff represented at the different committees.
- C. <u>All Campus Meeting, July 7, 2020</u>: There is an all-campus meeting with the president from 11 a.m. to 12 noon.

## Open Floor—10 minutes:

- A. <u>Work Reports</u>: Discussion on ways to be productive—referenced Diana Rodriguez' suggestions, e.g., take a class using tuition reimbursement, classes that may enhance job skills, communications, language, computer skills; read books, e.g., leadership, diversity; attend webinars and workshops, being mindful not to replace in leuiu of normal work duties.
- B. <u>Disney Tickets Drawing</u>: Shalita Tillman helped with the ticket selection for the Disney drawing. Tickets were given to all who attend senate meetings, and who helped volunteer and participate in Classified Senate activities during the current academic year. The winner of the drawing is Sarah Yearyean. Congratulations, Sarah!
- C. <u>Budget/Layoffs:</u> There was a question on layoff notices and the 60-day process.
