College Council Update April 12, 2023 Vice President, Student Services

Enrollment:

The year-to-date enrollment is currently up approximately 7% (+274.81 FTES) above last year at time. This includes 992 more students than a year ago (see chart below).

Priority Registration:

EOPS is promoting priority registration for all students; the goal is to encourage students to utilize their priority group and set their class schedules for the summer and fall semester; the Assessment computer lab is being used to assist students in person. Please encourage all students to meet with their counselors and register when their priority group is open (**Suggestions**: send messages to students through CANVAS to remind students to register).

Senior Day:

The college hosted over 600 seniors from the feeder high school districts to engage our feeder high schools from San Bernardino, Rialto, Colton, and Redlands Unified School Districts. We provided an educational and fun-filled day for all students, by offering:

- Campus tours
- Resource fairs
- Workshops
- Hands on demonstrations by our Art and CTE departments
- Exposure to campus life via clubs and Athletics
- Opportunities to engage with faculty and staff
- Opportunity drawings
