VPI Report	Status of Course Management System – Though CourseLeaf has not worked out for our new curriculum management				
	system, we have been collaborating with CHC searching for a new curriculum management system. We have looked at				
	the new CurricUNET, CourseDog, and Watermark. After a third demo from CourseDog, we will reconvene to make final				
	decisions. The feedback from Valley is swayed towards CurricUNET and Crafton has swayed towards CourseDog. Curriculum "Professional Development" Series – Mary would like to offer some 10–15-minute professional development				
	sessions that will be presented to the Committee starting Spring 2021. If anyone has a topic they would like to review,				
	let Mary know. Julie Ulloa had the idea of touching on course substitutions in degree and certificates by Modification of				
	Major. Specifically, the 50% rule or waiving units or course requirements.				
	Adding OER Field to CurricUNET — Mary Copeland wanted to add an area to the Course Checklist about OER under Resources.				
	Ethnic Studies Discipline Proposal – Colleen Calderon and Edward Gomez submitted a proposal for the new Ethnic Studies discipline. Per Mary Copeland, in the past when we have approved prefixes, our role as Curriculum Committee member is to place courses in disciplines, but as for hiring faculty, it is up to human resources to review.				
New Business	Per Colleen, this has been a long time coming. We have been talking about building this program for years and we already have courses that naturally fit in this area. This has not been an easy process, but the History department has been working collaboratively with Sociology and Anthropology on this, as well. This is not automatically a department; it is a discipline that will be an umbrella to meet the new CSU requirement. History curriculum will be updated to meet the needs to cross list with Ethnic Studies. This is a priority for our college to prepare our students and make a statement to say that ethnic studies is more than a discipline, it is reflecting our goals of supporting anti-racism.				
	Per Janice, the best way to go to begin with is to cross-list courses with Ethnic Studies.				
	Edward Gomez has taught Ethnic Studies at UCR, currently sits on the Ethnic Studies Console for community colleges, which has been meeting with the founders of this Ethnic Studies General Education area at the Cal State. Per Ed, the Cal States are requiring free-standing courses and must be approved by people who have an expertise in Ethnic Studies and that the courses go through the proper curriculum approval process. Janice explained that the terminology about faculty

	who have expertise in this area to review and approve this curriculum will occur during the articulation process with the Cal States.			
	Andrea Hecht asked where will this be housed? Per Dina, that will be determined once the curriculum is approved. Dina wanted to clarify role of Curriculum Committee. It is the role of the Curriculum Committee to place courses in disciplines and support faculty who propose new programs. The Ethnic Studies discipline already exists at the State level and it is the role of the Curriculum Committee to say we have courses that fit in this discipline. After approval, the VPI will work with HR to ensure we are hiring faculty meeting the minimum qualifications to teach in this discipline. Dina would like to applaud the Curriculum Committee for their Stance in developing anti-racism, anti-hate curriculum.

Old Business	Ethnic Studies/CSU GE Requirement – There has been some communication on the direction on how to move forward with Ethnic Studies. Courses that are going to be in the new CSU General Education area need to meet three of the five core competencies. We have not seen anything official on when this will be effective, but the CSUs have allowed us to backdate courses. When our curriculum is approved with a Fall 2022 effective date, students will still receive credit for the new GE area if they took the course in Fall 2021. Per Dina, after meeting with the Chancellor's Office last Friday, they reiterated that we have until Fall 2022 to fully implement this. A memo on this should be coming out early next year.			
	New World of Work (NWOW) – Mary met with the Curriculum Chair at Chaffey. Chaffey did not vet the NWOW through their Curriculum Committee or Senate, stating there are no changes to the curriculum, but Mary is proposing that the decision come from the Academic Senate instead of the Curriculum Committee since it requires additional work for faculty.
