	Thomas Berry presented a PowerPoint with the updated COR fields for Credit Courses and what the curriculum has completed by already adding to the COR and what still needs to be accomplished. b. Discussion: Determining the rationale for a 200 Level Course The presentation provided the Common Course Numbering Taxonomy as a starting point for a discussion on the rationale for 200 level courses determination at SBVC. The discussion was lively with several ideas to investigate and consider: i. 100 level is often general courses. ii. 200 level courses are considered advanced or beyond general courses. iii. There should be a collection of criteria to determine general vs. advanced courses. iv. A rubric for 100 and 200 level course criteria that is in the best interest of students should be considered. v. 200 level could be considered an expansion of introductory level. vi. 200 level could be considered advanced skill level in pathway. vii. 200 level courses should require prerequisites to be completed.

	x. 200 level should have higher cognitive expectations.
