1. Approval of 10/25/2022 Minutes	Amanda motions to approve. Sharaf second's motion. No objections. No abstentions.

2. Spring 2023 Enrollment Update Spring 2023 Priority Registration 10.31.22 to 11.17.22 Phone banking/Telemarketing	Spring 2023 – we have 1,507 head count which is close to 597 FTES. INPERSON CLASSES have increased by 5 percent. Many classes are in the morning. Dina introduced Gabriel Martinez as the research analyst for the office of instruction.	
	We will start phone banking the week of November 28 th . We see that the outreach, marketing, text, radio, billboards have been helping us move in the right direction. We are doing better than other schools and we want to continue in that momentum.	

3. Student Equity Plan Update– Carmen	Carmen has been working hard through writing sessions as we continue to build the student equity plan. We have a deadline on November 30 th . We have requested the plan be submitted by December 15 th to go through the board approval process. The goal is to be intentional with our African American population. We want to find ways how to support and show a sense of intentionality and make our students feel welcomed and heard.	
	Larry added that there was a focus group with approximately 25 African American population. To no surprise, many expressed how they did not feel welcomed. We are planning to meet with the students in December after the Student Equity Plan has been approved.	
4. Marketing Update – Paul	We are in the process of overhauling our website. A lot is happening behind the scenes through guided pathways. Keenan Giles has been working on the website.	
	To show you why web designs is important. Here's an example of the "apply" button update usage. There has been a spike in the last week of October. We are hoping that all these clicks went all the way through in applying. We in marketing are trying to figure out how to make the process seamless.	
	Another item, we are working on a virtual reality version of the campus. Other campuses have worked with Meta to build virtual campuses for online students. That space has been explored by other universities and colleges. We are also creating a version of the auditorium and the campus.	

We are in the process of launching our spring campaign. We are hoping for better results for what we saw in the fall. Our vendor is offering a secret shopper option. We are interested in seeing how the recent updates plays a role in the website. I encourage anyone, if you see anything on our website that is difficult to use, please reach out. We don't want people to waste time trying to go from point a to point b.

Keynasia asked how long have we had secret shoppers and how has it worked? Are they looking at the application only or is it extensive?

Paul responded that the secret shoppers will be looking at all of it. Information that we couldn't fix in marketing we reached out to other departments to fix issues.

Keynasia asked when we could get the results.

Paul answered that we should get the results in a few months.

Amanda noted that students don't have an issue with the application. The K-12 is linked up with the application. The application isn't the issue. The issue is webadvisor. It's hard to navigate. The password doesn't work sometimes. My question is are we going to do something about webadvisor?

Paul stated that we will be moving out of webadvisor.

April added that yes, we will be using a self-service platform.

Ron reiterated that a newer version of webadvisor is on the horizon.
