“My Path” Review and Usage of Career Assessment/Interest Inventory	Keenan – we are embedding a career and interest inventory on our website. “My Path” is currently used by Crafton and other colleges and supported by the Chancellor’s office. It makes the matriculation process more interactive, visual, guided and directive. Push notifications will be sent out which notifies students of their next steps. It’s embedded in the career and interest inventory.

Update on Self-Guided Placement for AB1705

Student Focus Group Discussion

Joe – great that we’re doing a soft launch over spring break. Thank you for letting us know.

Keenan – I appreciate your cooperation and responsiveness. It was a huge undertaking. Changes can still be made. We have a dedicated web developer.

Anthony – we are updating the STEM placement models. We need to make sure that High School students are not repeating coursework. We want to place students quickly into STEM. He shared the model that is being read through the Senate. There will be a second read tomorrow. We have until July 1st to meet compliance with Laserfiche. We will have that completed before school is out. He will connect with Patty since this affects the High School curriculum.

Anthony – we used a calculus grant to set up a student focus group for feedback on developing a calculus support class. Amy helped make this a success. We sent out a form to all calculus students. Students shared that they would love a support class before they take the parent course and preferred to see the professors in-person. He will share the feedback at the next math department meeting. Going forward I will work with Patty.

Keenan mentioned Trumba – it will be very useful for promoting events on campus. Calendar app is moving forward on the development side. He’s pushing for a student services communication team. Maybe it can be a collaborative effort. One thing that’s lacking is cohesive communication. Focus group can be dedicated to ensure events are being properly promoted on Trumba. Goal is for anyone to go to our website and easily search for events.

Maria stated that the library gets a lot of inquiries as to where events are taking place.

Christie mentioned that Laserfiche still needs things that need to be ironed out. The last placement pull she did on 3/1/23 had 7/5/22 as the most recent placement so it seems there are still bugs to be worked out. She would like to do additional analysis regarding the co-requisites and how they are or are not increasing the success in the core courses.

Anthony asked if she wanted to be included in the Laserfiche discussions.

Christie stated that she’s met with Gabriel regarding metrics for guided pathways and that they are always working on updating dashboards.

Gabriel stated that he will be cleaning up the data then implementing the dashboards to go public.

Joe stated that he’s looking forward to seeing the data and success rate on percentage of students that are self-selecting the courses that they were originally placed in.

Patty – we need to work on the State Chancellor’s Plan. We are working with the leads and will bring it back for the committee to review. She thanked everyone and the meeting was adjourned at 3:33p.m.
