- DSPS is seeking guidance and support from the SSSP committee with regards to their concerns of their student population in terms of Math & English course placement being modified by AB 705. Alicia presented information to the committee with regards to placement and data for DSPS students and how AB 705 could potentially impact their students. The committee agreed to assist and work with DSPS to ensure that their student population needs being meet as well. We discussed additional course offerings of developmental Math and/or English courses, curriculum guidance, and support courses.

- Course waiver form for students who elect to take a MATH and/or ENGLISH course other than what was recommended via the self-guided placement process, will be reviewed by the committee for approval target date (02/19).
- New assessment/survey testing is currently underway (accuplacer is schedule to phase out on (01/28/19) at this time student will begin using the new MMAP process for English and Math placement, we are in progress of building and testing the survey/placement process and will provide updates as we progress.
