

FREQUENTLY ASKED PARKING QUESTIONS

DO I NEED A PERMIT TO PARK ON CAMPUS?

No. At both Campus, CHC and SBVC, parking permits are not required in student parking lots for Fall 2020. Parking permits are required in staff parking lots all the time.

ARE THE CITATIONS ISSUED BY CAMPUS SECURITY OFFICERS AND COLLEGE POLICE 'REAL' TICKETS?

Yes. Citations are like any other ticket issued by a police or parking agency and are legally binding.

WHAT IF I DON'T TAKE CARE OF A TICKET I HAVE BEEN ISSUED?

If you neglect to take care of any outstanding citation, the ticket will incur a fine, the fine will double and a DMV hold will be placed on the vehicle.

WHAT IS A DMV HOLD?

A DMV hold occurs when a citation that is past due has incurred penalties, and the DMV has been notified to suspend the vehicle's registration until full payment for the citation is made. If there are multiple citations, full payment would need to be made before DMV would issue current registration.

DO I NEED A PERMIT IF I HAVE A VALID HANDICAP PLACARD?

Yes, a permit is needed to park on district property. Students with a Handicap Placard who have a student parking permit who park in staff lots are subject to citation.
