

LAUNCH Apprenticeship Network: Licensed Vocational Nurses (LVN) to Registered Nurse (RN) APPRENTICESHIP PATHWAY

San Bernardino Valley College (SBVC) Associate Degree Nursing program in partnership with PACS (Providence Administrative Consulting Services) and LAUNCH Apprenticeship Network offers qualified advanced placement applicants- LVNs, a pathway to attain their RN licensure.

LVNs must follow the same application process as all other applicants for the nursing program but are considered for admission from only LVN applicants. SBVC admits LVN to RN applicants every semester, of which applicants may be from LAUNCH Apprenticeship Network.

LVNs admitted into the program will be given the opportunity to challenge the first and second semester nursing courses. A student's final placement into either first, second or third semester of the nursing program will be dependent on passing the required challenge exams for first and second semester.

LVN TO RN Eligibility Requirements

- 1 year of full-time or 2 years of part-time (totaling 2080 hours) employment as an LVN.
- Detailed resume with documentation of past 5 year employment history, list of education and any skills or certification.
- Employment letter of verification with letter head and employer's signature.
- An active LVN license in good standing, and social security or tax ID number.
- LAUNCH/PROVIDENCE APPRENTICESHIP applicants will be evaluated using the multi-criteria point system.
- These applicants will still be required to complete all program prerequisites and application steps.

Required General Education Prerequisites: Complete the general education courses with a minimum G.P.A. of **3.0**:

- ENGL C1000 (Freshman Composition)
- Stat-C1000 (Statistics) or PSYCH 105 (Statistics for the Behavioral Sciences)

- COMM C1000 (Elements of Public Speaking) or COMM 111 (Interpersonal Communication)
- PSYCH C1000 (Introduction to Psychology)
- SOC 100 (Introduction to Sociology) or ANTHRO 102 (Cultural Anthropology)
- HUMANITIES (Choose one Art/Humanities courses)
 - Humanities are selected from [Area 3 of the SBVC Graduation Requirements](#).
- ETHNIC STUDIES (Choose one course)
 - One Ethnic Studies course from [Area 6 of the SBVC Graduation Requirements](#).

Required Science Prerequisites Complete the science courses below with a minimum G.P.A of **2.8**:

- BIOL *250 & *251 (Human Anatomy and Physiology I & II)
OR
- BIOL 260 & **261 (Human Anatomy & Human Physiology)
- BIOL **270 (Microbiology)

All sciences no longer have a science recency requirement or a repeat policy
