

Creating an OpenCCC Account

For first time students, the enrollment process begins with creating an OpenCCC.net account. In order to complete the application, you will need your social security number (if available). It is possible to complete the process without this number, but the fees assessed each student are different. Moreover, in order to clear any holds that come from not entering an SSN (or entering it incorrectly) you are required to present a physical card to the SBVC Admissions office within 2 weeks.

Step 1: Open SBVC's main website in an internet browser. (<u>https://www.valleycollege.edu</u>). Click the "Apply" link located in the top right corner.



Step 2: Select the "Click Here to Apply" icon. This will take you to the OpenCCC portal.



Step 3: Click on "Create an Account."

Application to College

Before applying to college you must first have an OpenCCC account.

The OpenCCC single sign-in account allows you to access the online services of the California Community Colleges.

OpenCCC is a service of the California Community Colleges Chancellors Office. The information in your account is kept private and secure.



Step 4: Click on "Begin Creating My Account."

OpenCCC allows you to access California Community Colleges secure web applications.

You Must Have an Email Address

The California Community Colleges and OpenCCC will use email to send you important information. You will need to provide an email address when you create your account.
