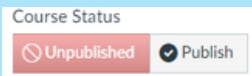

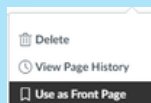
Make sure to hit "Publish" for your courses!

- Otherwise, students will not have access to your courses.



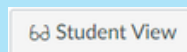
Choose your "Front Page" for each course.

- Choose any page in your Canvas course to be the "Front Page," which will be "Home."



Review each course in "Student View."

- Great way to make sure everything is accessible and open for students.



Set-up your account notifications for Canvas.

- Don't miss a submission, comment, or post!



Customize each course's detail settings.

- Keep the dates as "Term" or change to "Course;" restrict views or keep the course unrestricted.

Peer Review Enhancements:

- Updated Allocation Engine automatically pairs students based on available submissions instead of by student.

Learning Management Gradebook:

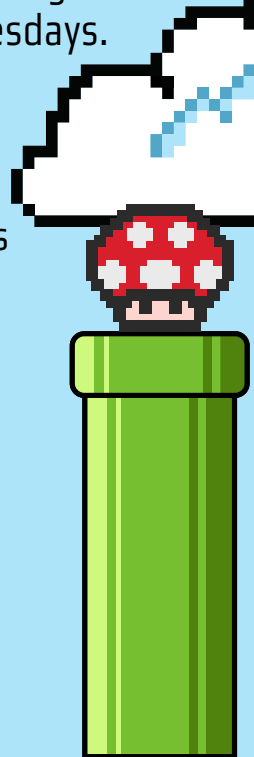
- More flexibility to search, sort, and customize how instructors view student mastery data.

Dashboard:

- Customizable for only students at the moment.

Notebook for Students:

- If enabled, students can capture and organize highlights and notes on pages directly within their course content.

At the end of Fall 2025, all PlayPosit videos and assignments were merged into the new program: WeVideo. While everything is still accessible, there may be issues when trying to edit your videos.
