CalFresh

CalFresh Food (SNAP) is a program that helps people buy food at their local farmer's market, grocery store, or online via an EBT card which is used like a debit card.



Where Can I Use SNAP EBT?

The SNAP Retailer Locator allows anyone to locate nearby SNAP-authorized retailers by entering a street address, city and state or zip code. Enter your starting location and select a retailer or map point to get details and directions.



Diaper Program

The Diaper Bank Program is sponsored by Community Action Partnership of San Bernardino County (CAPSBC).



Homeless & Housing Insecurity Program

This program provides connection to short/long term housing, resources, case management, and financial literacy in an effort to support housing stability in order for students to continue their pursuit of academic goals.
