Great ShakeOut Earthquake Drill

Our campus will be participating in the Great ShakeOut Drill this year. Participation will include a simple *“Drop, Cover, and Hold On”* exercise followed by an orderly evacuation to designated evacuation stations.

When the drill begins:

- Wherever you are, find protective cover — under a desk, table, or alongside sturdy furniture.
- If you are outside, move away from buildings or tall structures and into an open area.
- Remain in that position until the “shaking stops” (simulate approximately 20 seconds).
- After the simulated shaking, evacuate the building calmly and proceed to your designated evacuation site.
- Use stairways whenever possible; for the purpose of this drill, elevators may be used if necessary.

Once all buildings are evacuated, a notification will be made indicating it is safe to return to class or work. The entire drill should take approximately 15 minutes.

Communication modes used during the drill will include handheld radio, phone, and RAVE (text, email) alerts.
