Spring 2026 AI Faculty Survey

A survey was conducted by the Academic Senate AI Task Force from March 13 to April 6, 2026 to understand faculty experiences, concerns, and professional development needs related to artificial intelligence. Responses were used to directly shape the recommendations that the task force develop in Spring 2026, including an AI framework for teaching and learning, sample syllabus language, a professional development plan for Fall 2026, and input on the district's emerging AI policy (AP 3775).
