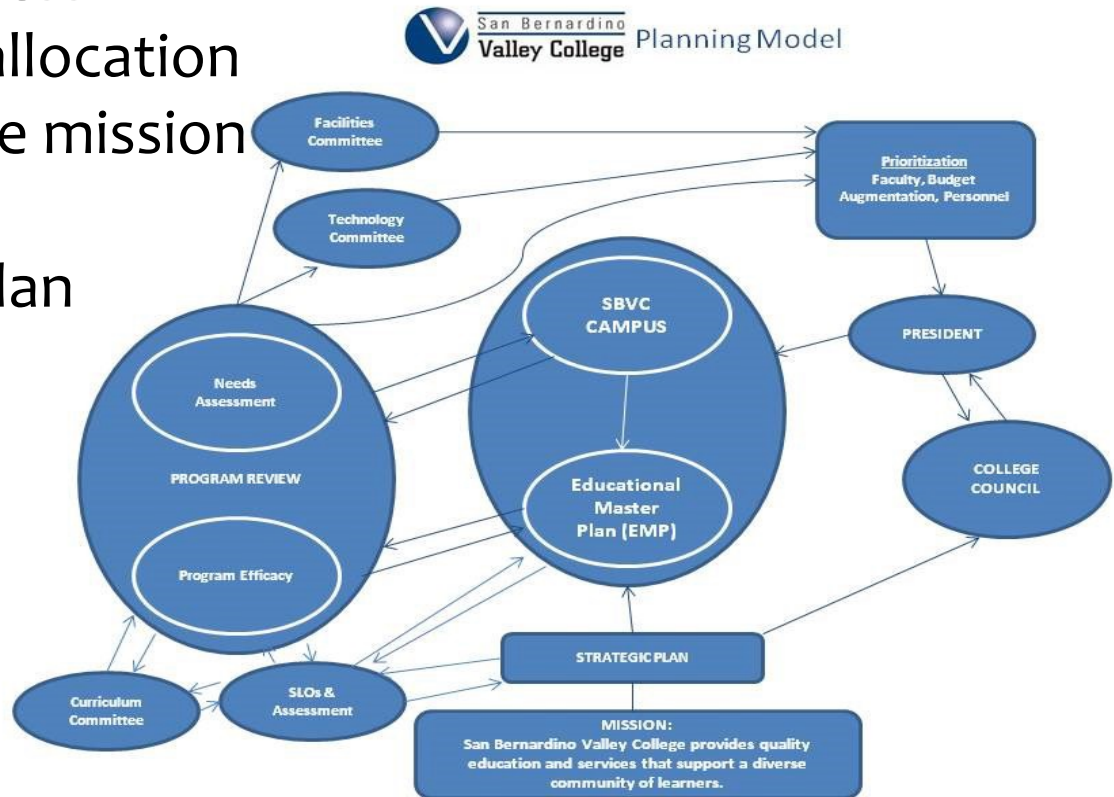

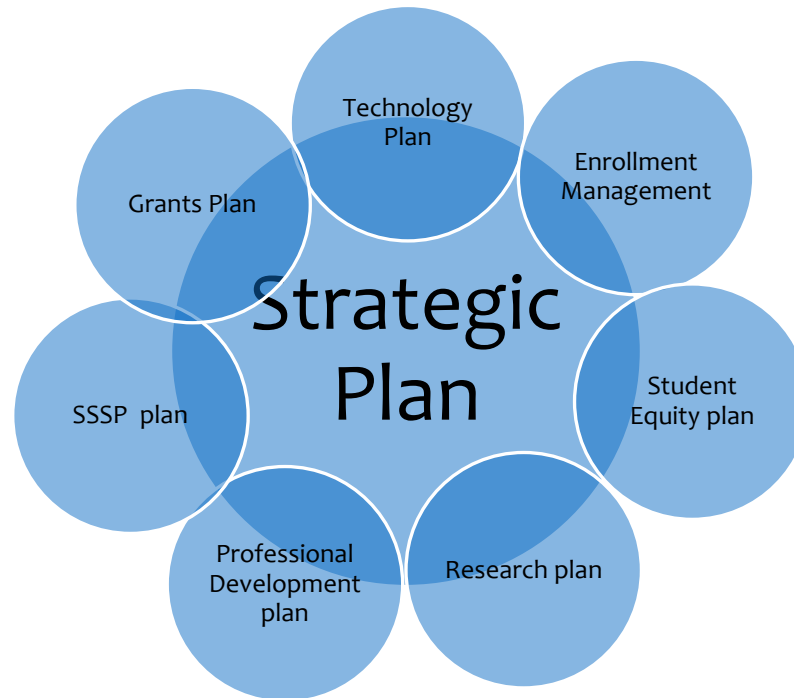

Institution-Set Standards

Institution-Set Standards are the level of performance set by the institution to meet educational quality and institutional effectiveness expectations. This number may differ from a performance improvement “goal” which an institution may aspire to meet.

- * YES! SBVC has Institution-Set Standards
- * Institution-Set Standards were established by the Academic Senate

The institution-set standard is the standard deviation below the mean over a seven-year period

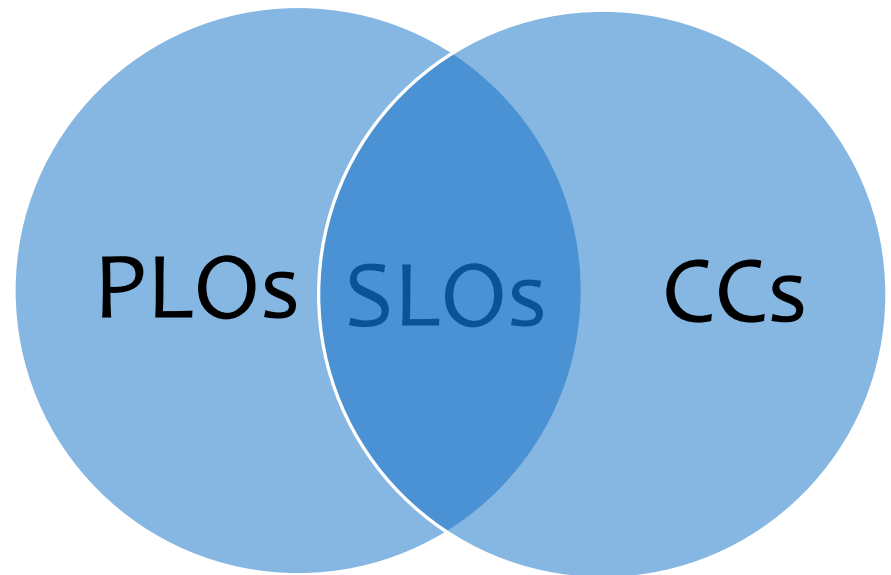
Instructional Outcomes

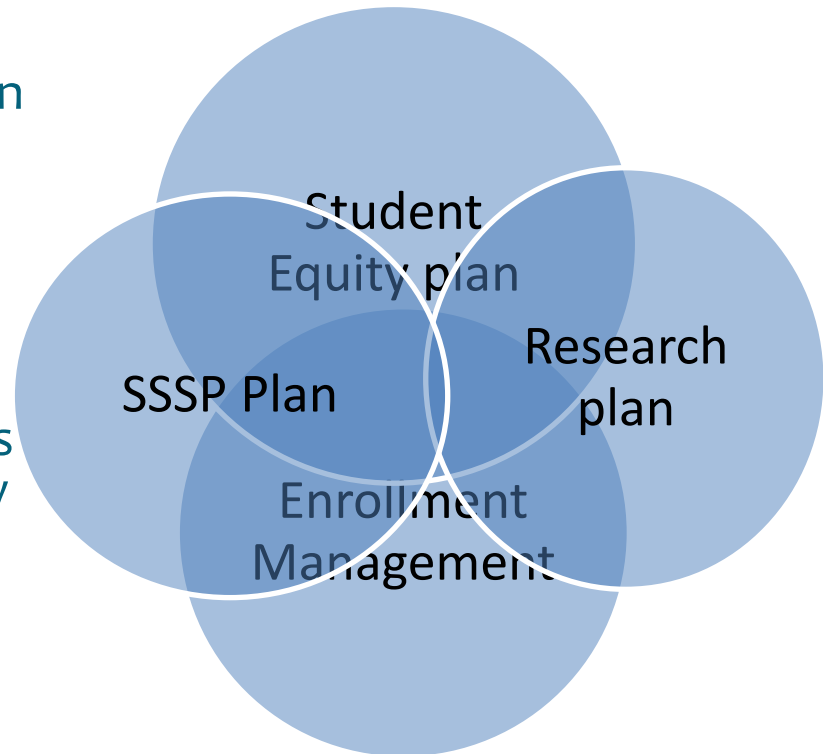

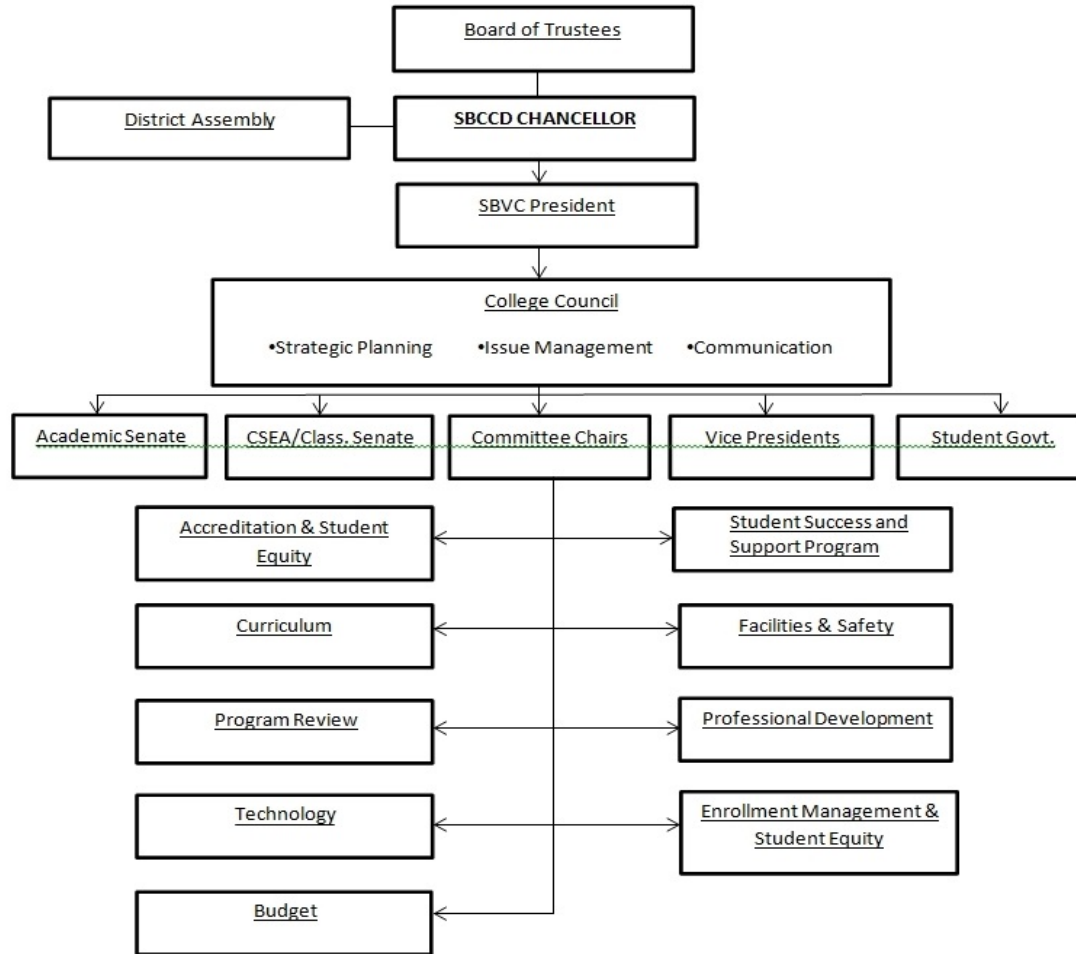
