What is SAP?

SAP stands for Satisfactory Academic Progress. It is the standard you are measured by to determine if you are making progress toward completing your degree. There are three components to a SAP Policy:

1. GPA
2. Completion Rate
3. Maximum Time Frame

If you do not meet SAP standards you may lose your financial aid eligibility.
