Can I still apply for financial aid if I don't have a high school diploma or GED?

All first-time SBVC students without a high school diploma or a GED enrolling in classes on or after July 1, 2012, <u>will not be</u> <u>eligible for federal financial aid</u> as a result of the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2012 passed by Congress. This law applies to all colleges and universities.

Students without a high school diploma or GED can still apply for scholarships and the Board of Governors (BOG) Waiver if they meet income and residency qualifications.
