



**TOEFL and IELTS Waiver Request Form**

All international students whose native language is not English must provide results of the Test of English as a Second Language (TOEFL) or the academic module of the International English Language Testing System (IELTS). If an international applicant's native language is English, or he/she has graduated from a college/university in which English was the language of instruction, or has met other case by case English proficiency requirements, an applicant may *request a waiver* of the TOEFL/IELTS. Those requesting a waiver should submit a completed form, along with *supporting documentation* demonstrating that English proficiency has been met.

***San Bernardino Valley College strongly encourages submission of the TOEFL or IELTS regardless of whether an international student has met waiver requirements.***
