BUSINESS

1. Student Discipline Regulations	Nikki Schaper, Director, Student Life and Sara Glasgow, Student Activities & Campus Center Specialist, presented their concerns with the Draft Student Discipline Regulations hearing process timelines, and the wording “reasonable opportunity be afforded the suspended person for a hearing within 10 days.” Nikki is concerned that 10 days is not a sufficient amount of time for the student to prepare for a hearing. Nikki and Sara will continue to review the process and timelines and return to College Council with their findings in 30 days.
2. Basic Skills as a Strategic Initiative	The Basic Skills as a Foundation for Student Success in California Community Colleges paper has been distributed and discussed throughout the campus. A discussion ensued concerning the use of the term “Developmental Educational Goals”. Some committee members felt that the term developmental connoted a different meaning than the one intended. John Stankas volunteered to write a starting place of options for the language and email it to the committee members.
3. Year End Report	James Smith reviewed the portion of the Year End Report that had not been reviewed at the previous meeting. James highlighted the accountability reporting for the Community Colleges (ARCC) Summary.
4. Logo Status	Deb reported that she had met with George McGinnis and discussed the proposed changes to the SBVC logo. Mr. McGinnis will work on the proposed changes and meet with Deb to review the new logo options.
