Any corrections or comments should be emailed to Rick. Linda Stevens commended Rick and the committee for their efforts.</p> <p>Social Science / Humanities was selected by College Council at their last meeting but since then, the faculty in Visual, Performing, and Media Arts object, stating that “Humanities” does not adequately represent what is in that building and therefore requested that it be placed back on the agenda. After a lengthy discussion, the committee recommended to name the North Hall replacement building Social Science/Humanities.</p> <p>Previous discussions were held concerning the inclusion of the words, San Bernardino Valley College in the V logo.
